






President Comments

2025 AGM



Thank you to everyone who attended our Annual General Meeting on 26 May, it was wonderful to see so many members engaged and contributing ideas for the future of our club.

Here are some key highlights from the meeting:

The 2025 AGM marked a year of growth and resilience for NCDTC. Despite early changes in leadership, the committee delivered a full calendar of events including our first Scent Work Trial, a Championship Obedience & Rally-O Show, and a successful Ribbon Trial.

We celebrated our 10th anniversary with a special evening and awarded life memberships. Training expanded with new classes in Amberley and Rangiora, and the club launched a new website. Membership held steady at 56, with over 140 dogs participating in classes.

Financially, the club remains strong, with increased assets and continued investment in member benefits such as equipment, trainer development, and event resources. Fees will remain unchanged for 2025/2026.

Elections confirmed Cheryl Baumber as President, Judith Moore as Vice President, Deana Lyons as Secretary, and Susan Dalzell as Treasurer. Committee members include Lesandre Paris, Jodie Corbett, and Barry Primmer.

Constitutional updates were passed to meet the new Incorporated Societies Act, including changes to auditor requirements and club purpose. A new award in memory of Anne was proposed, and the club will explore recognising member/dog title achievements with ribbons.

We're halfway through the term and seeing some awesome progress especially in shaping and engagement work.


